

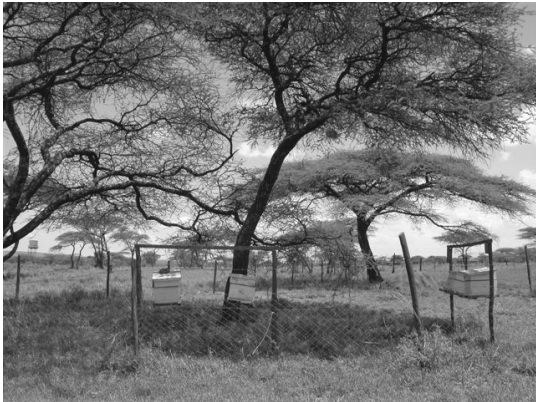

Growing Lasting Solutions to Hunger...

Foods Resource Bank (FRB) has established a gift program for those who wish to make a legacy gift.

Should I consider a Legacy Gift?

As the Scriptures remind us, there is a time for everything, including a time to sow and a time to reap, and a time to live and a time to die. In that spirit, we acknowledge that there is also a time for giving when, after a lifetime of sharing with those in need, individuals and families can have a unique and significant impact on the work of God's Kingdom. Many arrive at a point where they will consider the future and what they may do with the assets that they have earned and accumulated over their lifetime, or perhaps over generations.

FRB recognizes that as you plan for the future of your estate, you may wish to provide resources for the continued work of FRB. Your investment in FRB will bring sustainable transformation in people and communities in the developing world.



The FRB Time for Giving Fund:

The purpose of the fund is to honor the donor wishing to have a sustained impact, while at the same time recognizing the current needs of FRB's programming.

A gift to this fund will:

- Be invested following a conservative strategy, for a period of 7 years.
- The principal amount of the gift, along with any accrued earnings, will be used over the course a 7 year period to further FRB's work in ministry and mission around the world.
- 10% of the gift will be put to work in the first year, followed by 15% of the appreciated balance in each of the following six years.

The FRB Endowment Fund:

A gift to this fund will be invested to ensure maximum long term benefit for FRB's programming and operations.

A gift to this fund will:

- Maintain a perpetual fund to support future years of FRB's work in the developing world.
- Release a percentage of the current balance based on the average of the prior three year's earnings, to be approved annually by the Board of Directors
- Be used to support FRB's program and operating budget as needed.

A time for giving...

The FRB Land Trust:

A gift of land is very special. FRB recognizes the relational, livelihood and historic importance that farmland has to families and communities. The FRB Land Trust will work to honor the desires that people have for their land. Since each situation is unique, FRB hopes to engage people individually as opportunities for a gift of land arise.

Policies that govern how land is received by FRB include:

- Minimum acreage that can be accepted and held in trust, to be decided by the FRB Board of Directors.
- Land can be held by FRB and used to produce program revenue (either stand-alone or as part of a larger Growing Project) provided that arrangements are made by the donor to support the ongoing cost and administration of said land.
- An agreement will be made on how long the land must be held in trust by FRB prior to possible liquidation, and the rules under which any future sale might be governed. This would include an option for the donor's family to repurchase the land, as well as any restrictions that may be stipulated by the donor.
